An Act granting to Her Majesty certain sums of Money for the Public Service for the Fiscal Years ending respectively on March 31, 2014 and on March 31, 2015

(Assented to _____)

MOST GRACIOUS SOVEREIGN:

Whereas it appears by a message from the Honourable the Lieutenant Governor of Saskatchewan, and the estimates accompanying the message, that the sums mentioned in this Act are required to defray certain charges and expenses of the public service of Saskatchewan not otherwise provided for during the fiscal years ending respectively on March 31, 2014 and on March 31, 2015;

May it therefore please Your Majesty, that it may be enacted and be it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan, as follows:

Short title

1 This Act may be cited as *The Appropriation Act, 2014 (No. 1)*.

Fiscal year ending March 31, 2014

2 There may be paid out of the general revenue fund a sum not exceeding \$57,241,000 to be applied towards defraying the charges and expenses of the public service for the fiscal year ending on March 31, 2014, not otherwise provided for, and being the amount of each of the sums granted, as set forth in Schedule A.

Fiscal year ending March 31, 2015

3 There may be paid out of the general revenue fund a sum not exceeding \$11,453,418,000 to be applied towards defraying the charges and expenses of the public service for the fiscal year ending on March 31, 2015, not otherwise provided for, and being the amount of each of the sums granted, as set forth in Schedule B.

Use of funds

4 The sums appropriated by this Act shall be paid and applied only in accordance with and for the purposes set forth in this Act, including the schedules to this Act, and in the detailed estimates and votes on which the schedules to this Act are based.

Accounting

5 The application of all moneys expended pursuant to this Act shall be accounted for to Her Majesty.

Coming into force

6 This Act comes into force on assent and remains in force until October 31, 2015.
