An Act to make consequential amendments to *The Saskatchewan Employment Act* resulting from the enactment of *The Saskatchewan Human Rights Code, 2017*

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

Short title

1 This Act may be cited as *The Saskatchewan Human Rights Consequential Amendment Act, 2017*.

SS 2013, c S-15.1 amended

2(1) *The Saskatchewan Employment Act* is amended in the manner set forth in this section.

(2) Subsection 2-21(5) is repealed and the following substituted:

“(5) No employer shall pay an employee a different rate of pay on the basis of any prohibited ground, as defined in *The Saskatchewan Human Rights Code, 2017*, unless *The Saskatchewan Human Rights Code, 2017* permits the different rate of pay”.

(3) Subsection 2-40(5) is amended by striking out “*The Saskatchewan Human Rights Code*” and substituting “*The Saskatchewan Human Rights Code, 2017*”.

(4) Section 2-45 is amended by striking out “*The Saskatchewan Human Rights Code*” and substituting “*The Saskatchewan Human Rights Code, 2017*”.

(5) Subsection 4-6(4) is amended by striking out “sections 31.2 to 31.5 of *The Saskatchewan Human Rights Code*” and substituting “sections 38 to 41 of *The Saskatchewan Human Rights Code, 2017*”.

Coming into force

3 This Act comes into force on the day on which section 1 of *The Saskatchewan Human Rights Code, 2017* comes into force.
