QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

The following responses to written questions were tabled by the government:

Question no. 335 (Mr. Forbes):

To the Minister of Labour Relations and Workplace Safety: How many Workers' Compensation Board (WCB) claims of psychological injury have been reported and accepted from workers in the retail sector?

Answer:

For 2015-2017, 90 claims of psychological injury have been reported in the retail sector. Of these, 24 have been accepted.

Question no. 336 (Mr. Forbes):

To the Minister of Labour Relations and Workplace Safety: How many employers within the retail sector have seen an increase in their WCB premiums or other charges related to an increase in WCB claims due to violence in the workplace?

Answer:

Due to the complexity of the WCB's rate setting and experience rating processes, we cannot determine the impact of specific claims on an individual employer's premium rate.

Question no. 337 (Mr. Forbes):

To the Minister of Labour Relations and Workplace Safety: How many WCB claims of psychological injury have been reported in 2015?

Answer:

In 2015, 414 WCB claims of psychological injury were reported.

Question no. 338 (Mr. Forbes):

To the Minister of Labour Relations and Workplace Safety: How many WCB claims of psychological injury have been accepted in 2015?

Answer:

To date, 113 WCB claims of psychological injury that were reported in 2015 have been accepted.

Question no. 339 (Mr. Forbes):

To the Minister of Labour Relations and Workplace Safety: What has been the time loss due to WCB claims of psychological injury in 2015?

Answer

In 2015, WCB claims of psychological injury reported in 2015 accounted for 2,358 full days of time loss.

Question no. 340 (Mr. Forbes):

To the Minister of Labour Relations and Workplace Safety: What has been the average duration in days due to WCB claim of psychological injury in 2015?

Answer:

The average duration for WCB claims of psychological injury reported in 2015 was 39.97 days.

Question no. 341 (Mr. Forbes):

To the Minister of Labour Relations and Workplace Safety: How many WCB claims of psychological injury have been accepted that had no time loss in 2015?

Answer

To date, 24 claims of psychological injury registered in 2015 have been accepted with no time loss.

Question no. 342 (Mr. Forbes):

To the Minister of Labour Relations and Workplace Safety: How many WCB claims of psychological injury have been disallowed in 2015?

Answer:

To date, 299 WCB claims of psychological injury that were reported in 2015 have been disallowed.

Question no. 343 (Mr. Forbes):

To the Minister of Labour Relations and Workplace Safety: How many WCB claims of psychological injury have been reported in 2016?

In 2016, 424 WCB claims of psychological injury were reported.

To date, 116 WCB claims of psychological injury that were reported in 2016 have been accepted.

Question no. 345 (Mr. Forbes):

To the Minister of Labour Relations and Workplace Safety: What has been the time loss due to WCB claims of psychological injury in 2016?

Answer:

WCB claims of psychological injury reported in 2016 accounted for 4,072 full days of time loss.

Question no. 346 (Mr. Forbes):

To the Minister of Labour Relations and Workplace Safety: What has been the average duration in days due to WCB claims of psychological injury in 2016?

Answer:

The average duration for WCB claims of psychological injury reported in 2016 was 61.70 days.

To date, 30 claims of psychological injury registered in 2016 have been accepted with no time loss.

To date, 308 WCB claims of psychological injury that were reported in 2016 have been disallowed.

Since November 1, 2016, 190 WCB claims of psychological injury have been reported.

To date, 62 WCB claims of psychological injury that have been reported since November 1, 2016, have been accepted.

Answer:

WCB claims of psychological injury reported since November 1, 2016 accounted for 1,168 full days of time loss.

Answer:

The average duration for WCB claims of psychological injury reported since November 1, 2016 is 41.71 days.

To the Minister of Labour Relations and Workplace Safety: How many WCB claims of psychological injury have been accepted that had no time loss since November 1, 2016?

Answer:

To date, 26 claims of psychological injury registered since November 1, 2016 have been accepted with no time loss.

Answer:

To date, 106 WCB claims of psychological injury that have been reported since November 1, 2016, have been disallowed.
