STATEMENT BY THE SPEAKER (Deferred Ruling)

Earlier today the Government House Leader (Hon. Mr. Merriman) raised a question of privilege under the provisions of rule 12 of *The Rules and Procedures of the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan*. Upon receipt of this notice, in accordance with the rules, both House Leaders were informed of the details of the case and the proposed question of privilege.

It is the responsibility of the Speaker to determine if a *prima facie* case of privilege has been established. Contempt of the Assembly is a serious charge, which requires careful examination of the case and this Assembly's practices and precedents. I wish to inform the Assembly that I have not had sufficient time to reach a decision on this question, so for this reason I shall defer my ruling.

Members are not to discuss or debate the matter of a possibility of leaked information. This is a very serious charge that I do not take lightly. I ask all members to heighten the decorum in this Assembly. We should have vigorous debate in this Assembly on ideas and policies, but we should not debate the character of honourable members from both sides of the Assembly. Today, in question period, I will have zero patience for any members that challenge the principles that this Assembly has been built on.
