PRAYERS

STATEMENT BY THE SPEAKER (Members' Decorum)

Yesterday, right on the heels of my ruling, the Member for Estevan (Ms. Carr) made a statement that was inflammatory. It was not helpful. The statement is an example of what happens when members on both sides of this Chamber engage in demeaning rancour. A pattern has been developing and it is unworthy of this Assembly and is of considerable concern to me. The comments and the questions I ruled out of order yesterday are good examples of the negative spiral that can occur when members start impugning each other's character in this Chamber.

I ask members to be cognizant of the tone, manner, and intention of their remarks and to measure their language accordingly in this Assembly.

SEVENTY-FIVE MINUTE DEBATE

That this Assembly condemns the Sask Party government for their 2017/18 budget that hiked taxes, cut services to the province's most vulnerable, and demonstrated the Sask. Party's inability to manage the province's finances; and

That this Assembly condemns the Sask. Party government for their continued mismanagement of the economy that has slowed job growth, hurt businesses, and has Saskatchewan families paying more.

A debate arising and the period of seventy-five minutes having expired, pursuant to rule 25(5), the Deputy Speaker interrupted proceedings.

PRIVATE MEMBERS' MOTIONS

That this Assembly rejects the NDP's plan to increase spending by over \$2.5 billion, as it would leave Saskatchewan with an extreme deficit and increase the debt of future generations.

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

Answer:

As of March 28, 2018, there are 70 licensed oil pipelines that cross lakes, rivers, and tributaries that are a source, or are upstream of a source, of a municipal water supply.

Question no. 192 (Ms. Sproule):

To the Government, how many pipelines crossing lakes, rivers, and tributaries to municipal water supplies have been inspected since July 1, 2016?

Answer:

Since July 1, 2016, the Ministry of Energy and Resources has conducted 153 inspections of oil pipelines that cross lakes, rivers, and tributaries that are a source, or are upstream of a source, of a municipal water supply.

Question no. 193 (Ms. Sproule):

To the Government, how many inspections of pipelines crossing lakes, rivers, and tributaries to municipal water supplies have led to penalties, fines, or recommendations requiring follow-up since July 1, 2016?

Answer:

Since July 1, 2016, the Ministry of Energy and Resources has issued forty-seven (47) notices as a result of inspections of oil pipelines that cross lakes, rivers, and tributaries that are a source, or are upstream of a source, of a municipal water supply. All of these issues were addressed by the licence holder and none posed an immediate risk to the integrity of the pipeline. No penalties or fines were issued during this period.
