- (b) After the last grazing season in 2019-20 the accumulated amount will be closed out and transferred to General Revenue Fund.

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Question no. 249 (Mr. Forbes):

To the Minister of Environment, (a) in terms of the funding provided to SARCAN how is this funding level determined (formula, proportion of sales, etc.), (b) have there been any changes to the particulars in determining funding in the last five fiscal years, and if so, how, and (c) are there any planned changes to the particulars of funding in the next five years, if so, what are they?

Answer:

- (a) SARCAN receives funding based on environmental handling charges collected from beverage container sales from two years prior.
- (b) There has been no change to this funding model in the last five years.
- (c) The current SARCAN contract expires March 31, 2020 and will be renegotiated. SARCAN will receive an additional \$0.01 per container beginning in 2020-21.
