QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

The following responses to written questions were tabled by the government:

Question no. 287 (Ms. Sproule):

To the Government, (a) in terms of ministries that have contracts with the Canadian Public Safety Operations Organization (CanOps), what was the value of the contract, (b) what are the deliverables of the contract, and (c) what is the term of the contract?

Answer:

- (a) The contract is currently valued at \$9,002,750 annually with anticipated reductions in the amount owed to CanOps based on their collection of alternate revenue related to dispatching services (estimated at \$1,300,000). One-time payments in the contract are for transition costs of \$250,000 and a prepayment of \$2,175,688 to ensure CanOps has sufficient funds to cover costs, such as salaries, as payments under the contract are made after the end of each applicable month. The prepayment will be repaid to the ministry under the terms of the agreement.
- (b) The deliverables of the contract are to operate the Prince Albert public safety answering point that handles 911 services in Saskatchewan outside of the cities of Saskatoon and Regina.
- (c) The term of the contract is 10 years with an option to renew for one additional term of five years.
