Answer:

- (a) The full-time equivalents (FTEs) for registered nurse (RN) and registered psychiatric nurse (RPN) working in former rural Regional Health Authorities (RHAs) for each year since 2006-07 are shown in the following table. Data excludes Regina Qu'Appelle Health Region (RQHR) and Saskatoon Health Region (SHR). However, those health regions covered a significant amount of rural areas in the province.

**Question no. 309 (Ms. Chartier):**

**Question no. 310 (Ms. Chartier):**

To the Minister of Health, (a) for each fiscal year since 2006-07, how many Saskatchewan physicians ceased practicing medicine in the province less than two years after their recruitment, (b) of the Saskatchewan physicians who ceased practicing medicine in the province in less than two years after their recruitment, how many were working in rural communities, and (c) how many physicians working in rural communities moved from their rural communities in the first two years of their practice?

**Question no. 311 (Mr. Forbes):**

To the Government, for each year since 1980, how many times did the Saskatchewan Human Rights Tribunal take the case of a person who experienced discrimination on the basis of their disability to the courts?

Answer:

Prior to 2011, the only access to the courts was through an application by a party for a judicial review of a Saskatchewan Human Rights Tribunal decision.

Since the Court of Queen's Bench started acting as a deciding body in 2011:

- The Commission has only litigated three cases, none of which were for discrimination on the basis of disability.
- The Commission has referred 58 cases of alleged discrimination on the basis of disability to the Court of Queen's Bench. Almost all matters were resolved by directed mediation or during the Queen's Bench pre-hearing process. Only a very small number of matters proceed to a hearing.

**Question no. 312 (Mr. Forbes):**

To the Government, when was the last time the government reviewed the targets for hiring people with disabilities in executive government and Crown corporations?

Answer:

The Government of Saskatchewan's (GoS) goals for diversity group representation are based on goals identified by the Saskatchewan Human Rights Commission (SHRC). These goals are based on the representative population of the province. The GoS reviews the SHRC goals annually to determine if they have changed. In 2014-15, the representation goal for persons with a disability was 9.7% and the goal was adjusted by the SHRC in 2015-16 to 12.4%. CIC and the subsidiary Crown corporations compile demographics information annually and report with reference to targets set by the Saskatchewan Human Rights Commission.

**Question no. 313 (Mr. Forbes):**

To the Government, what person or office sets the targets for hiring people with disabilities in executive government and Crown corporations?

Answer:

The Government of Saskatchewan's (GoS) goals for diversity group representation are based on goals identified by the Saskatchewan Human Rights Commission (SHRC). The SHRC sets goals for diversity group representation, including goals for persons with a disability. The GoS is committed to these goals and is working toward a representative workforce based on these numbers. CIC and the subsidiary Crown corporations use targets set by the Saskatchewan Human Rights Commission to guide hiring and conduct demographics measurement.

**Question no. 314 (Mr. Forbes):**

To the Government, how does the government set the targets for hiring people with disabilities in executive government and Crown corporations?

Answer:

The Saskatchewan Human Rights Commission (SHRC) sets goals for diversity group representation, including goals for persons with a disability.
