## QUESTIONS ORDERED FOR RETURN

**The following written questions were converted and order for returns were issued:**

**Return no. 1 (Ms. Sarauer):**

To the Minister of Justice and Attorney General, for each fiscal year since 2007-08, of the funding allocated to Legal Aid Saskatchewan, the amount that was (a) provincial, and (b) federal.

**Return no. 2 (Ms. Sarauer):**

To the Minister of Health, with regards to addiction beds, (a) the number that have been created since November 2007, (b) where they are located, (c) what type they are, and (d) which organization operates the facility where they are housed.

**Return no. 3 (Ms. Sarauer):**

To the Minister of Health, which rural hospitals have had no emergency services and had to temporarily close in 2017 and 2018.
