QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

The following responses to written questions were tabled by the government:

Question no. 54 (Ms. Beck):

To the Minister of Education, in terms of consultations that took place before and in the process of drafting Bill No. 157 — The Education Amendment Act, 2018, (a) what groups, individuals, and organizations were consulted, and (b) what were the dates of all and any consultations?

Answer:

- (a) Ministry of Government Relations and the Ministry of Justice. The Saskatchewan Professional Teachers Regulatory Board. The Infrastructure Advisory Committee (IAC) which includes members from the Saskatchewan School Boards Association (SSBA), Saskatchewan Association of School Business Officials (SASBO), League of Educational Administrators, Directors and Superintendents of Saskatchewan (LEADS), Saskatchewan Teachers' Federation (STF), Federation of Saskatchewan Indian Nations (FSIN), Metis Nation Saskatchewan (MN-S) Ministry of Justice and the Ministry of Education.
- (b) Consultation occurred in May and June 2018. Consultation occurred on January 30, 2017, and June 14 and 21, 2018. Initial consultations commenced at a June 2014 committee meeting and subsequent consultations continued with the committee until March 2018. Consultation occurred between May 2018 and October 2018.

Question no. 55 (Ms. Beck):

To the Minister of Education, in terms of restricted teaching certificates, (a) how many are currently active in the province, (b) how many in each school division, (c) how many were issued in each school year since 2013–14, and (d) what are the required qualifications for the position?

Answer:

The Ministry of Education does not issue restricted teaching certificates.

Question no. 56 (Ms. Beck):

To the Minister of Education, in terms of temporary teaching permits, (a) how many are currently active in the province, (b) how many in each school division, (c) how many were issued in each school year since 2013–14, and (d) what are the required qualifications for the position?
