STATEMENT BY THE SPEAKER (Unparliamentary Language)

Before we move into today's proceedings, I need to address the Assembly on a matter arising from yesterday's proceedings.

While I was pleased that the Member from Regina Elphinstone-Centre (Mr. McCall) took the initiative to stand, apologize, and withdraw his egregiously unparliamentary language, I must address the content of the apology.

Yesterday's *Hansard* clearly shows that the Member from Regina Elphinstone-Centre used a specific expletive in what was supposed to be an apology for unparliamentary language. Apologies are not excuses to reoffend. The use of any unparliamentary language in an apology is absolutely unacceptable. The use of an expletive is even worse. This is not the standard of conduct that the citizens of this fine province deserve of their elected members. The decorum we show in this Assembly is not merely out of respect for each other, it is instead an expression of the respect we all owe the constituents we represent. As the Speaker, I can not allow the matter to stand.

I ask members to be mindful of this and be respectful to the institution they serve.
