QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

The following responses to written questions were tabled by the government:

Question no. 113 (Ms. Chartier):

To the Minister of Health, what programs, services and organizations had funding from the ministry reduced in the 2019–20 budget?

Answer:

There were no reductions in the Ministry of Health's 2019–20 budget.

Question no. 115 (Mr. Pedersen):

To the Minister of Environment, in terms of *The Wildlife Habitat Protection Act* infractions investigated in each of the past five years, (a) how many alleged or suspected infractions were investigated, (b) how many resulted in charges, (c) what category of charges did each fall into, and (d) what was the nature of the alleged offense?

Answer:

- (a) Two alleged or suspected infractions were investigated.
- (b) One investigation resulted in a charge.
- (c) The charge that deals with *The Wildlife Habitat Protection Act* was a summary offence.
- (d) Nature of alleged offence:
 - i. The subject built a road through a grazing co-op without approval. The land in question is agriculture crown lease and *The Wildlife Habitat Protection Act* lands.
 - ii. Altered the ecological lands by cultivating an area of native grassland.

Question no. 116 (Mr. Pedersen):

To the Minister of Finance, for each of the last 15 fiscal years, (a) how many individuals reported income which would have been subject to the highest marginal income tax rate (before assessing any applicable credits), and (b) what was the aggregate amount of income tax calculated on those individuals' tax returns (before assessment of any applicable credits)?

- The table above does not accurately represent the number of actual taxpayers or net taxes payable by Saskatchewan taxpayers in each respective taxation year, as the totals do not include the application of Saskatchewan's non-refundable tax credits (NRTC's) or other Saskatchewan-specific tax incentives.
- Once NRTC's such as the basic personal exemption amount (\$15,843 per tax filer), and the dependant child amount (\$6,010 per eligible child) have been applied, many individuals initially reporting taxable incomes will have reduced their tax burden to zero. In 2016 Saskatchewan had the second highest basic personal exemption amount and the highest dependant child amount in Canada.

To the Minister of Health, according to the most recent data, (a) the number of addictions counsellors that are in the provincial opioid agonist therapy (OAT) program, and (b) the number of patients across the province that are receiving methadone or suboxone for addictions in the OAT program.

Return no. 72 (Ms. Chartier):

To the Minister of Health, in terms of the OAT program, (a) the number of addictions counsellors working in the OAT program in each of Saskatoon, Regina, Prince Albert, North Battleford, Moose Jaw, Weyburn, and La Ronge, and (b) the number of patients that are supported in each location.
