The following questions were given notice on day no. 46 and are to be answered by day no. 51:

1. Ms. Sproule, to ask the government the following question no. 235:

To the Minister Responsible for Saskatchewan Power Corporation: How many times, and when, has the amine solution, used at the carbon capture and storage (CCS) facility at Boundary dam, been replaced?

2. Ms. Sproule, to ask the government the following question no. 236:

To the Minister Responsible for Saskatchewan Power Corporation: What was the total cost of the equipment installed on July 2016 to filter the amine solution at the CCS facility at Boundary dam?

3. Ms. Sproule, to ask the government the following question no. 237:

To the Minister Responsible for Saskatchewan Power Corporation: For each month since July 2016, what was the degradation of the amine solution at the CCS facility at Boundary dam?

4. Ms. Beck, to ask the government the following question no. 238:

To the Minister of Education: For each school division, what is the operating deficit for the 2016-17 school year?

5. Ms. Beck, to ask the government the following question no. 239:

To the Minister of Education: For each school division, how much money was used from reserves to pay for operating costs in the 2016-17 school year?

6. Ms. Rancourt, to ask the government the following question no. 240:

To the Minister of Social Services: (1) How many vacancies, and for what positions, were there for the child and family services unit at the Prince Albert service centre as of March 2016? (2) July 2016? (3) September 2016? (4) November 2016 (to date)?

7. Ms. Rancourt, to ask the government the following question no. 241:

To the Minister of Social Services: (1) How many social workers have ben seconded from across the province to work at child and family services at the Prince Albert service centre in September 2016? (2) October 2016? (3) November 2016 (to date)?

To the Minister of Social Services: (1) What are the total travel, accommodation, and per diem costs for social workers providing services through child and family services at the Prince Albert service centre in September 2016? (2) October 2016? (3) November 2016 (to date)?

9. Ms. Sproule, to ask the government the following question no. 243:

To the Minister Responsible for the Saskatchewan Power Corporation: (1) How much money has the corporation spent on amine in each year since the Boundary dam 3 (BD3) unit was retrofitted with carbon capture and storage technology? (2) How much money has the corporation spent on cleaning amine in each year since the BD3 unit was retrofitted with carbon capture and storage technology?
