To the Minister of Health, in terms of mental health beds and patients, (a) what is the average operating census at the Dubé Centre for the last four fiscal years (2015/16, 2016/17, 2017/18, and 2018/19) broken out by adult beds and children and youth, (b) how many patients were admitted to Saskatchewan Hospital North Battleford (SHNB) rehabilitation beds in 2017/18 and 2018/19 (best available date for the most recent fiscal year), (c) in 2017/18 and 2018/19, how many people had two or more acute inpatient hospitalizations in a designated mental health bed in a Saskatchewan hospital, (d) in 2017/18 and 2018/19, how many people had an acute inpatient hospitalization in a designated mental health bed in a Saskatchewan hospital where the entire hospital stay was more than 60 days, and (e) in 2017/18 and 2018/19, how many people had three or more acute inpatient hospitalizations in a designated mental health bed in a Saskatchewan hospital?

To the Minister of Health, in terms of publicly-funded addictions treatment facilities for both detox and inpatient services in 2013/14, 2014/15, 2015/16, 2016/17, 2017/18, and 2018/19, (a) what was the average wait time for adult men, (b) what was the average wait time for adult women, (c) what was the average wait time for youth girls, and (d) what was the average wait time for youth boys?

To the Minister of Health, for each acute psychiatric centre in the province, what was the longest stay in 2018/19 for adults, and children/youth?

To the Minister of Health, in 2018/19, what was the average wait time from emergency department decisions to admit to admission to each of the acute psychiatric centres across the province for adults, and children/youth?

5. Question no. 81 (Ms. Chartier):

To the Minister of Health, for each former health region, how many children and youth, in the mild and moderate categories, are waiting for an initial outpatient mental health appointment as of March 31, 2019?

6. Question no. 82 (Ms. Chartier):

To the Minister of Health, for each fiscal year since 2013/14, how many publicly-funded addictions residential treatment beds have been available to Saskatchewan residents for men, women, youth girls, and youth boys?

7. Question no. 83 (Ms. Chartier):

To the Minister of Health, what was the average wait time for each publicly-funded addictions treatment facility including both inpatient and detox services for the 2018/19 fiscal year?

8. Question no. 84 (Ms. Chartier):

To the Minister of Health, in the 2017/18 and 2018/19 fiscal years, what was the longest inpatient length of stay (in days) in a Saskatchewan hospital where part or all of the stay was spent in a designated mental health ward?
