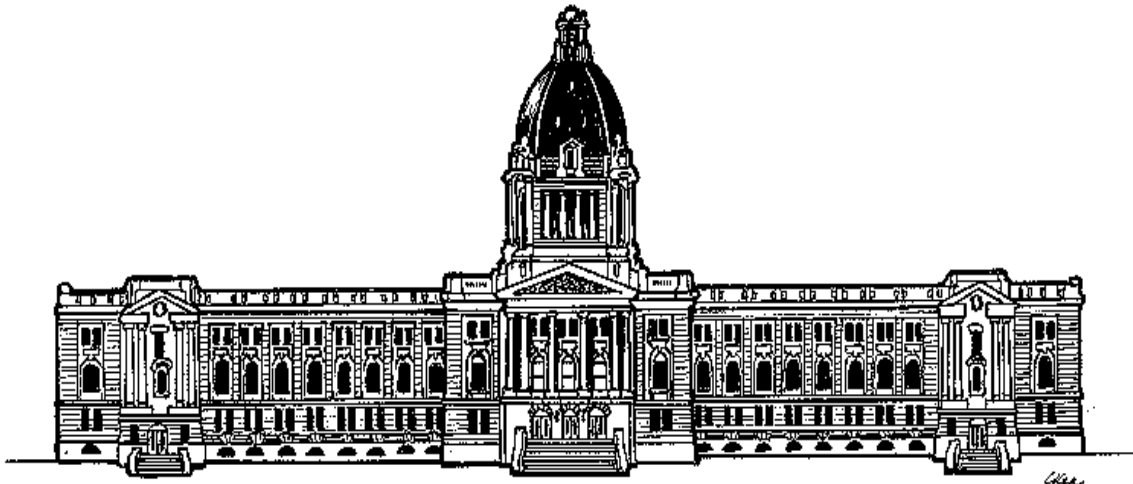

[The committee met at 11:31.]

**The Chair:** — Good morning. This is the Standing Committee on Intergovernmental Affairs and Justice. We will resume with our negotiations or discussions in regard to the lobbying legislation. As we do this, we will be . . . Well I should introduce the panel first. I'm sorry. My name is Warren Michelson. I am the Chair of the Intergovernmental Affairs and Justice. Along with this, other committee members are Cathy Sproule, the Deputy Chair; Kevin Phillips; Warren Steinley; Lyle Stewart; Christine Tell; and Corey Tochor.

As we go into discussions regarding the lobbying legislation, we will be going into camera. I would ask for some member . . . [inaudible interjection] . . . Thank you.

Before we go into camera we have an intern with us this afternoon, Cody Gieni. Is that right? Cody. Cody has requested that he stay for the discussions in camera. We would need a motion to allow Cody to remain. Ms. Sproule.

Ms. Sproule made the motion:

That the committee do now meet in camera and that Cody Gieni be permitted to remain in attendance.

Is that approved?

**Some Hon. Members:** — Agreed.

**The Chair:** — Carried.

Welcome, Cody. Welcome, committee members. We will now go in camera to discuss the lobbying legislation.

[The committee continued in camera from 11:33 until 11:54.]

**The Chair:** — Well welcome back as we conclude our in camera discussions. We now proceed to the report. Ms. Sproule, is there a motion that you wanted to make?

**Ms. Sproule:** — I'd like to make the following motion, Mr. Chair:

That pursuant to rule 135(2) the committee include a minority opinion to the second report of the Standing Committee on Intergovernmental Affairs and Justice.

I so move.

**The Chair:** — Ms. Sproule has made a motion that we include a minority opinion. Is there any discussion on the . . . No discussion. Okay.

All those in favour of the minority opinion accompanying the report? Those opposed . . . [inaudible interjection] . . . Okay, let's do this again. Those in favour of the minority report being filed? Those opposed? That's carried that we will file the minority opinion with the report.

Further to that, a motion is required to adopt and present the report to the Assembly. I would ask a member to make that

motion. Mr. Stewart.

**Mr. Stewart:** — I move:

That the draft second report of the Standing Committee on Intergovernmental Affairs and Justice be adopted and presented to the Assembly.

**The Chair:** — Mr. Stewart has made a motion that we report this to the Assembly. All those in favour?

**Some Hon. Members:** — Agreed.

**The Chair:** — That'll be carried.

Thank you committee members. We now need a motion to adjourn. I would ask a member to move a motion of adjournment. Mr. Tochor has moved that we adjourn. All agreed?

**Some Hon. Members:** — Agreed.

**The Chair:** — That is carried. Thank you to the committee members.
