2. The Chair advised the committee that pursuant to rule 148(1), the March supplementary estimates for the following ministry were committed to the committee on March 22, 2017:

3. The committee considered Bill No. 47, *An Act to Reduce Salaries of Members of the Legislative Assembly, 2017/Loi de 2017 réduisant les traitements à verser aux membres de l'Assemblée législative*.

Hon. Jeremy Harrison, member of Executive Council, appeared before the committee and answered questions.

4. The question being put on clause 1, it was agreed to.

5. During consideration of clause 2, it was moved by Mr. Forbes:

Amend Clause 2 of the Printed Bill, by striking out 46.1(c), as being enacted by Clause 2 of the Printed Bill.

Modifier l'article 2 du projet de loi imprimé, par la suppression de 46.1 (c), tel qu'il est édicté par l'article 2 du projet de loi imprimé.

A debate arising and the question being put on the amendment, it was defeated.

6. During consideration of clause 2, it was moved by Mr. Forbes:

Amend Clause 2 of the Printed Bill, by adding the following after proposed section 46.1:

Maximum payments — Members of Executive Council

46.2(1) Notwithstanding any other Act, law

Modifiez l'article 2 du projet de loi imprimé, en ajoutant ce qui suit après l'article 46.1 proposé:

Paiements maximaux — Membres du Conseil exécutif

or Order-in-Council, any member who is also a member of executive council is not entitled to and must not receive more than \$39,175 in annual salary funded from the General Revenue Fund.

(2) Any amount that exceeds the maximum set out in subsection (1) is a debt due to the Crown and may be recovered pursuant to *The Financial Administration Act*, 1993.

46.2(1) Nonobstant toutes droits, lois, ou l'Ordre autorize par le lieutenant gouverneur en conseil, un député qui aussi un member du conseil exécutif ne peut pas recevoir plus de \$39,175 de traitement payé sur le fonds du revenue générale.

(2) Tout montant qui dépasse le maximum mentionné dans l'alinéa (1), est une dette Dette payable à la Couronne et peut être récupérée selon la loi intitulée *The Financial Administration Act*, 1993.
