Date of Occurrence	Board of Education	Description	Amount	Action Taken
March 3, 2017	Light of Christ RCSSD No. 16	Two laptops were stolen from the grade 6/7 classroom at a school. School staff discovered the theft when the laptops were not available the following week.	\$ 783	A report was filed with the RCMP. All computers have been moved from the classroom to the library. Students must sign out laptops and the librarian checks for laptops not returned at the end of each school day.
Summer 2016	Prairie Spirit SD No. 206	An overhead projector was stolen from a 25 foot ceiling in a school theatre. This happened in the Summer of 2016 during a construction project. Access to the location was quite limited (only available via the catwalk), but, due to the ongoing construction, the alarm system was not working properly	\$ 6,650	The stage doors now remain locked at all times unless specific access is needed. Access to catwalk through mechanical room now has increased protocol for access. Police were provided with details.
March 16, 21 & 27, 2017	Regina RCSSD No. 81	Break and enter at a school. Cash, cash register, and miscellaneous items stolen	\$ 3,851	Video surveillance provided to Regina Police Service. Suspect apprehended. Alarm codes re-programmed, outdoor locks and keys replaced, school staff conducted review and assessment of safety protocols. Restitution pending.
October 24, 2016	Saskatoon SD No. 13	Theft of laptop and projector	\$ 1,312.30	Reported to police and reviewed security processes at the school.
October 28, 2016	Saskatoon SD No. 13	Stolen laptop.	\$ 785.40	Reported to police and reviewed security processes at the school.
