To stop the federal government from imposing a carbon tax on the province.
(Addendum to sessional paper no. 16)

To immediately call for a judicial inquiry and forensic audit into the GTH (Global Transportation Hub) land deal.
(Addendum to sessional paper no. 25)

To restore the governance structure of the Wascana Centre Authority and end the commercialization of Wascana Park.
(Addendum to sessional paper no. 26)

To adopt a plan to raise the minimum wage to \$15 an hour for all workers.
(Addendum to sessional paper no. 43)

To immediately support the establishment of universal pharmacare.

(Addendum to sessional paper no. 44)

SEVENTY-FIVE MINUTE DEBATE

The order of the day being called for the following motion for a seventy-five minute debate, it was moved by Ms. Sarauer:

That this Assembly calls on the Sask Party government to reverse its takeover of Wascana Park and restore the board structure of the former Wascana Centre Authority; and

That this Assembly calls on the Sask Party government to stop the four-story office building as proposed and ensure that the CNIB is able to build a new facility that meets its needs while maintaining the integrity of Wascana Park.

A debate arising and the period of seventy-five minutes having expired, pursuant to rule 25(5) the Deputy Speaker interrupted proceedings.

The Assembly resumed the adjourned debate on the proposed **motion no. 1**, moved by Mr. Hindley:
