To the Minister of Health, for all Saskatchewan Health Authority funded detox sites (both brief and social combined), how many naloxone kits had to be thrown out because they reached their 'best before' expiration date since the program began?

**2. Question no. 45 (Ms. Chartier):**

To the Minister of Health, how many discreet clients have Saskatchewan Health Authority-funded brief detox sites seen in 2014–15, 2015–16, 2016–17, 2017–18, 2018–19, and 2019–20 (to date)?

**3. Question no. 46 (Ms. Chartier):**

To the Minister of Health, how many discreet clients have Saskatchewan Health Authority-funded social detox sites seen in 2014–15, 2015–16, 2016–17, 2017–18, 2018–19, and 2019–20 (to date)?
