An Act to amend *The Traffic Safety Act*

(Assented to)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

Short title

1 This Act may be cited as *The Traffic Safety (Miscellaneous) Amendment Act, 2022*.

2 *The Traffic Safety Act* is amended in the manner set forth in this Act.

Section 48 amended

3 **Clause 48(2)(c) is amended:**

(a) **by adding** “prescribed circumstances or” **after** “as a result of”; **and**

(b) **by adding** “within prescribed periods” **after** “prescribed offences”.

Section 148.1 amended

4 **Subsection 148.1(3) is repealed and the following substituted:**

“(3) A driver mentioned in subsection (1) may apply to enrol in a prescribed ignition interlock program on the prescribed date”.

Section 257 amended

5 **Subsection 257(2) is amended by adding** “or damages for bereavement” **after** “non-economic loss”.

Section 287 amended

6 **Subsection 287(1) is amended:**

(a) **by adding the following clause after clause (u):**

“(u.1) respecting demerit points, including, for the purposes of clause 48(2)(c) and section 49, prescribing:

(i) the number of demerit points, and the period within which they are accumulated, that will lead to the cancellation or suspension of, or refusal to issue, a person’s driver’s licence;

(ii) offences and other circumstances that carry demerit points;

(iii) the circumstances in which the administrator may reduce the number of demerit points accumulated by a person; and

(iv) the penalties for accumulating the prescribed number of demerit points within the period prescribed in subclause (i)”; **and**

TRAFFIC SAFETY (MISCELLANEOUS) AMENDMENT ACT, 2022

(b) by adding the following clause after clause (uu):

“(uu.1) prescribing the manner and format in which certificates, permits, driver’s licences, and any other document issued or otherwise generated by the administrator or on the administrator’s behalf may be presented, shown, or displayed by a driver or person to whom the certificate, permit, driver’s licence or document was issued”.

Coming into force

- 7(1) Subject to subsection (2), this Act comes into force on assent.
- (2) Section 4 comes into force by order of the Lieutenant Governor in Council.
