## An Act to make consequential amendments resulting from the enactment of *The King's Bench Act*

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

### Short title

1 This Act may be cited as *The King's Bench Consequential Amendments Act, 2023*.
