Chair Goudy: — I'd like to call the meeting 5/25 to order at 9:01 a.m. Joining us today from the government are Hon. Tim McLeod, Hon. Lori Carr, MLA [Member of the Legislative Assembly] Sean Wilson, and MLA Kevin Weedmark. From the opposition are MLA Nicole Sarauer and MLA Matt Love.

Approval of the proposed agenda for meeting 5/25?

Hon. Lori Carr: — I so move.

Chair Goudy: — Lori Carr. And a seconder?

Hon. Tim McLeod: — I'll second.

Chair Goudy: — Tim McLeod. All in favour?

Some Hon. Members: — Agreed.

Chair Goudy: — Carried. Minutes. Approval of the minutes for 4/25?

Kevin Weedmark: — I so move.

Chair Goudy: — Mr. Weedmark. And a seconder? Matt Love.

So I'd like to table all the documents, items 1 through 9. You should have them in your packages there. Sorry about yesterday's late . . . You know, has everybody had a chance to glance through them?

Okay. Item 10, directive #31, Anti-Harassment Policy amendments. Minister McLeod.

Hon. Tim McLeod: — Thank you, Mr. Chair. I would move:

That the Board of Internal Economy in accordance with subsection 4(d) of directive #31, Anti-Harassment Policy, approve the Anti-Harassment Policy 2025 proposed amendments; and

That the amended policy be published with the directives of the Board of Internal Economy.

Chair Goudy: — Seconder? Nicole Sarauer. Any questions about the changes? We've got Marie here if there's any questions on the changes. Okay. So discussion item, vote 21 . . . [inaudible interjection] . . . Okay, the motion before us:
