Mr. Park: — Welcome back and good morning once again. So the committee has received a letter of resignation from Mr. Brkich. Since he has resigned as Chair, it is my duty as the Committee Clerk of the Standing Committee on Intergovernmental Affairs and Justice to preside over the election of a new Chair.

I will first ask for nominations. Once there are no further nominations, I will then ask a member to move the motion to have a committee member preside as Chair. I will now call for nominations for the position of committee Chair. Mr. Lawrence.

Mr. Lawrence: — I nominate Laura Ross.

Mr. Park: — Mr. Lawrence has nominated Ms. Ross. Any further nominations? Seeing none, I would ask the member to move the motion.

Mr. Lawrence: —

That Laura Ross be elected to preside as Chair of the Standing Committee on Intergovernmental Affairs and Justice.

Mr. Park: — All right. Mr. Lawrence has moved:

That Laura Ross be elected to preside as Chair of the Standing Committee on Intergovernmental Affairs and Justice.

Is that agreed?

Some Hon. Members: — Agreed.

Mr. Park: — I declare the motion carried. Although we do have a committee Chair and a Deputy Chair, they are not able to be here today. As such, the committee will need to act an electing Chair for this meeting, so we'll follow the same process we just followed.

I will ask for nominations. Once there are no further nominations, I will ask the member to move a motion for the committee member to preside as acting committee Chair. I will now call for nominations for the position of acting committee Chair. Mr. Phillips.

Mr. Phillips: — I would nominate Eric Olauson.

Mr. Park: — Mr. Phillips has nominated Mr. Olauson. I see no further nominations. I will ask the member to move the motion, please.

Mr. Phillips: — I would move:

That Eric Olauson be elected to preside as Acting Chair of the Standing Committee on Intergovernmental Affairs and Justice for the meeting of September 6, 2017.

Mr. Park: — Thank you very much, Mr. Phillips. Mr. Phillips has moved:

That Mr. Olauson be elected to preside as Acting Chair of the Standing Committee on Intergovernmental Affairs and Justice for the meeting of September 6th, 2017.

Is that agreed?

Some Hon. Members: — Agreed.

Mr. Park: — I declare the motion carried. I'll ask Mr. Olauson to take the Chair, please.

The Acting Chair (Mr. Olauson): — Well good morning. I would like to table the following documents: IAJ 8-28, Ministry of Government Relations: Responses to questions raised at the April 12, 2017 meeting dated June 7, 2017; IAJ 9-28, Ministry of Government Relations: Responses to questions raised at the May 9, 2017 meeting dated June 13, 2017.

Seeing that we have completed our business for today, I would ask a member to move a motion for adjournment. Mr. Lawrence. Is that agreed?

Some Hon. Members: — Agreed.

The Acting Chair (Mr. Olauson): — Carried. This committee stands adjourned to the call of the Chair.
