The following is a list of items that the Ministry was asked to provide additional information on:

#### 1. Chapters 34 and 36 – Health Shared Services Saskatchewan – Shared Procurement

Question:

Provide a split of procurement types for years 2016 and 2017.

Response:

The contracts are listed below in two categories:

- Goods – medical/surgical, diagnostic imaging, housekeeping, lab, office, therapies, prosthetics, dietary non-foods, other; and,
- Pharmacy – drugs.

In the fall of 2015, Prairie North Regional Health Authority implemented and trained staff on its new fall-prevention program.

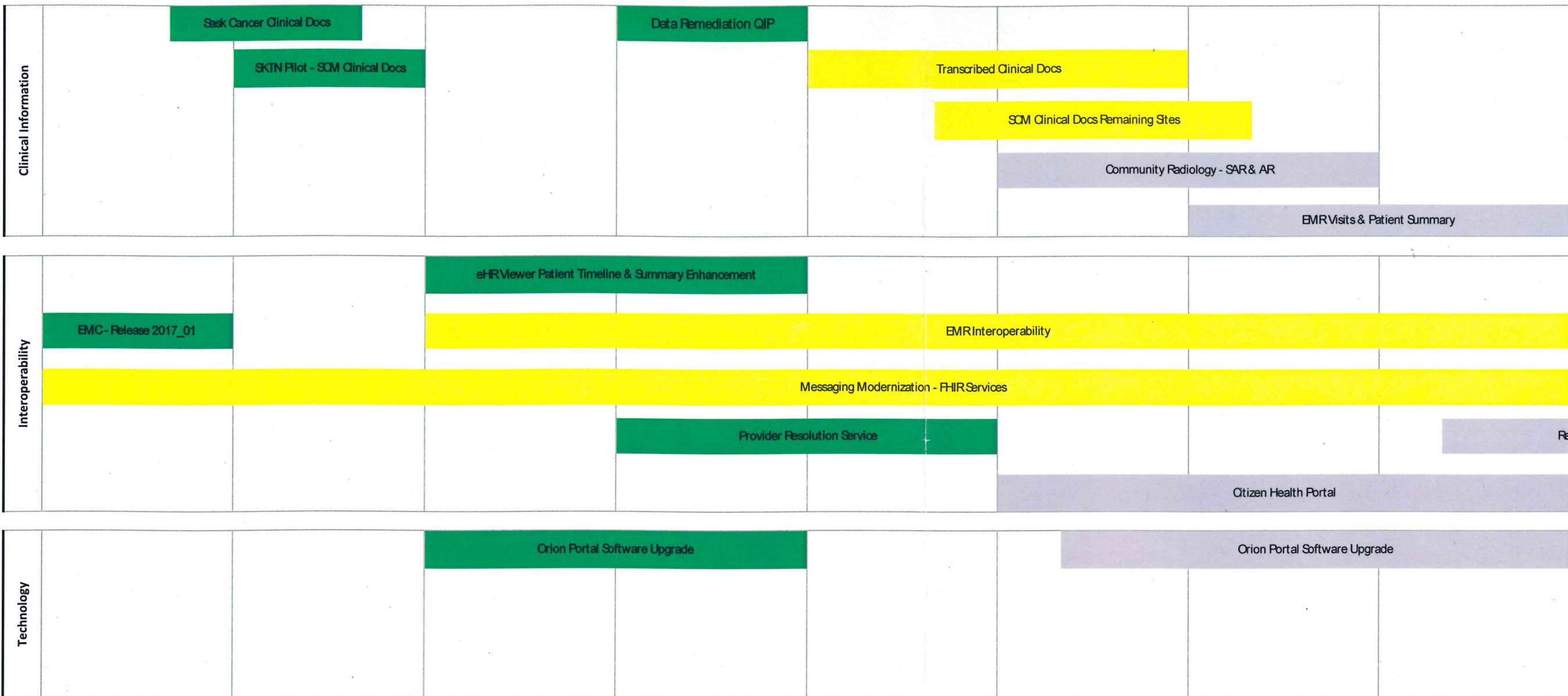
