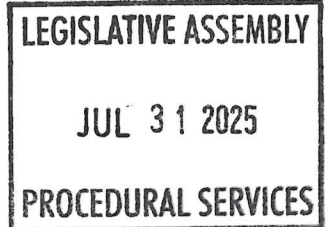

Report of Public Losses for Ministries and Treasury Board Crowns¹
2025-26 First Quarter Report - for the Period April 1, 2025 to June 30, 2025

Date of Occurrence	Entity	Description	Amount	Action Taken
April 2015 to July 2022	Ministry of Immigration and Career Training ²	Based on a Royal Canadian Mounted Police (RCMP) investigation, a former employee of the Saskatchewan Immigration Nominee Program (SINP) is alleged to have fraudulently altered documents and procedures, accessed government databases for unauthorized purposes and engaged in conflicts of interest and obtained over \$650,000 from SINP participants. These allegations have not been substantiated in court.	No known loss to the government	The employee resigned in August 2022 and was charged in May 2025 after an RCMP investigation.
April 2020 to March 2025	Ministry of Social Services	An employee of a non-government Community Based Organization (CBO) that provides services funded by the government misappropriated funds through use of a purchase card for personal items.	\$27,500.34	The CBO terminated the employee. The CBO is working through a restorative justice approach and will repay the loss.

¹ Includes losses of money or property greater than \$500 that are due to fraud or similar illegal acts by employees, suppliers or contractors.

² While there is no known loss to the government, given the nature and significance of the fraud involving a government employee, it is being reported.
