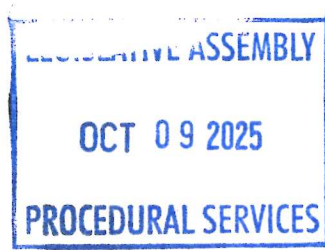

Losses of Public Money¹

Losses Reported by Boards of Education for the Period June 1, 2025, to August 31, 2025

Date of Occurrence	Board of Education	Description	Amount	Action Taken
July 25, 2025	Sun West School Division No. 207	Payroll amount was misdirected to an inappropriate bank account as a result of someone fraudulently impersonating an employee and initiating a change to banking information. ²	\$5,599	Efforts to recover the funds were unsuccessful. The incident was reported to the RCMP, insurer, and external auditor. The school division will require additional confirmation through direct contact to verify future changes to banking information, followed by implementation of an employee log-in system for any changes to personnel information.

¹ Includes losses of money or property greater than \$500 that have been reported by school divisions that are due to fraud or similar illegal acts by employees, suppliers or contractors of the school division.

² While employee, supplier or contractor involvement is not suspected, given the loss is due to fraud and its significance, it is being reported.
