Losses Reported by Boards of Education for the Period September 1, 2025 to November 30, 2025

Date of Occurrence	Board of Education	Description	Amount	Action Taken
January to mid- September 2025	Prairie South School Division No. 210	An employee used a cardlock gas card to make unauthorized gas purchases.	\$2,016	The employee is no longer employed by the school division, and the matter has been reported to the police.
January 2024 to June 2025	Lloydminster Roman Catholic Separate School Division No. 89	An employee misappropriated funds including cash and the use of a corporate purchase card for personal items.	\$16,161	The matter has been reported to the RCMP and the employee is no longer employed with the school division. Thus far, the school division has been able to recover \$10,341 and the former employee has committed to making payments to return the remaining
