EVENING SITTING

Hon. Mr. Shillington: — I would ask for leave to return to private members' motions.

Mr. Martens: — I understand it's motions for returns (debatable).

Leave granted.

MOTIONS FOR RETURNS (Debatable)

Return No. 3

Mr. Martens: — Mr. Speaker, I move that an order of the Assembly do issue for a return showing:

Regarding the Crown Investments Corporation of Saskatchewan, the number of people that had their employment terminated for any reason in the month of April, 1992, and provide: (a) the name, (b) salary, (c) title, (d) severance and other payments made by reason of the employment termination, (e) vote under which the salary and other payments were made to the terminated employee, and (f) the name of the replacement employee, if any, and the vote under which that employee is paid.

I move, seconded by the member from Wilkie.

Mr. D'Autremont: — Thank you, Mr. Speaker. I would like to move an amendment to this motion, and that:

The amendment read to delete the words "in the month of April, 1992".

I would present this motion, Mr. Speaker, seconded by the member from Kindersley . . . the amendment, sorry.

Hon. Mr. Shillington: — The government will be voting against the amendment. The reason, simply put, is that there are 188 of these motions. An enormous amount of our staff time has gone into preparing for these. We're simply unprepared for this. We don't know if it's available, and at this stage in the session, we're going to vote against this amendment. It is open to the members to file new motions if they so wish. But we are prepared to deal with this as we have it, but we are not prepared to deal with it as we've amended it. We've not had the time to do that so we are going to vote against this amendment.

Mr. Martens: — I suppose that it wouldn't be in order for me to ask the minister a question as to whether they're going to vote for or against the motion. I would assume though, however, that they're prepared to move to the point where they will accept the motion as it has been presented. And what we'll do is go through the first one to find out where the game plan is and then deal with it from there on. Thank you.

Amendment negated on division.

Hon. Mr. Shillington: — Technically I'm not sure if I need leave or not to speak again. I'm not sure if it was concurrent before. Let me just say very . . .

The Speaker: — Let me check for a minute. I'm not sure whether you have spoken or not. I don't believe the member has spoken to the main motion, therefore he may speak again.

Hon. Mr. Shillington: — We have just provided to the official opposition an amendment. At the conclusion of my remarks, which will be extremely brief, we're going to delete parts (3) and (4) and make (5), (3) and (6), (4) and so on. The basic reason we are doing this is that the information is provided in answers (1) and (2) and is not compiled separately. So in just a second here . . . It's not precisely as we've given it to the opposition, and it's just to see if you're going to read this or not. Actually what I'm going to do is delete part (c) and (d), make (e), (c), and (f), (d). I just inserted the numbers to see if you're following closely.

An Hon. Member: — Yes, which ones were you going to delete?

Hon. Mr. Shillington: — We're going to delete part (c). Now that may be simpler. With apologies to the page, I am going to now move we:

Delete parts (c) and (d) and make (e), (c), and (f), (d).

I so move, seconded by the member from Moose Jaw Wakamow.

The Speaker: — I will have to ask the member, somebody, to explain this to me because I . . .

Hon. Mr. Shillington: — . . . but perhaps not that clearly. We are deleting (c) and (d); renumbering (e) as (c) and (f) as (d). The comments under "rationale" have been stroked out and are not part of the motion.

The Speaker: — If the member . . . Order. If I can maybe be of some assistance to the House in making an intelligible amendment out of this by simply saying the following:

That the amendment will delete (c) and (d), and renumber (e) and (f) as (c) and (d).

Is that what the member . . .

Hon. Mr. Shillington: — Yes, that's right.

The Speaker: — Will the members therefore take that as the amendment:

To delete (c) and (d) and renumber (e) and (f) as (c) and (d).

Does everybody understand the amendment?

Amendment agreed to on division.
