QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

Mr. McMorris asked the Government the following Question No. 485, which was answered by the Hon. Mr. Taylor:

To the Minister of Health: What is the total amount of money spent on recruitment and retention initiatives, to date, for all health care professionals combined for the fiscal year 2006/07?

Answer:

In the 2006/07 fiscal year our government has spent over \$41.5M on recruitment and retention initiatives, for all health care professionals.

Mr. McMorris asked the Government the following Question No. 486, which was answered by the Hon. Mr. Taylor:

To the Minister of Health: What is the total amount of money spent on recruitment and retention initiatives for all health care professionals combined for the fiscal year 2005/06?

Answer:

In the 2005/06 fiscal year our government spent over \$29.8M on recruitment and retention initiatives, for all health care professionals.

Mr. McMorris asked the Government the following Question No. 487, which was answered by the Hon. Ms. Atkinson:

To the Minister of Learning: What is the cost per physician training seat at the College of Medicine?

Answer:

The cost to the Government of Saskatchewan is \$300,000 for the full four years of the undergraduate program. This figure does not include the cost paid for by the student through tuition fees.

Mr. McMorris asked the Government the following Question No. 488, which was answered by the Hon. Ms. Atkinson:

To the Minister of Learning: What is the cost per physician residency spot at the College of Medicine?

Answer:

The academic cost is \$37,500 for each year of the residency. Residencies have different lengths (e.g. family medicine is two years while anesthesiology is five years). In addition, residents are paid a salary during their residency for the clinical services they perform. Salaries and benefits start at about \$50,000 per year for residents in their first year.
