## QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

**Ms. Chartier asked the Government the following Question No. 872, which was answered by the Hon. Mr. Hutchinson:**

To the Minister of Tourism, Parks, Culture and Sport: What were the key findings and/or recommendations of the Blackstrap Provincial Park report?

Answer:

The consultant's report provides for a phased redevelopment of the park over several years. It recommends that the ministry develop recreation opportunities consistent with Blackstrap's natural setting.

**Ms. Chartier asked the Government the following Question No. 873, which was answered by the Hon. Mr. Hutchinson:**

To the Minister of Tourism, Parks, Culture and Sport: (1) Where is the report on Blackstrap Provincial Park that former Minister Duncan said would be complete by late summer 2010? (2) Has the report been released publicly? (3) If not, is there a plan to release the report publicly? (4) If not, why not?

Answer:

- (1) The ministry has received the consultant's report for Blackstrap Provincial Park. The ministry is currently reviewing the report and recommendations.
- (2) The consultant's report has not been released to the public.
- (3) After it has been reviewed and considered, it will be released.
- (4) Same as above.

**Ms. Chartier asked the Government the following Question No. 874, which was answered by the Hon. Mr. Hutchinson:**

To the Minister of Tourism, Parks, Culture and Sport: How many businesses adjacent to provincial parks have no-competition clauses disallowing services within parks?

Answer:

Businesses operating adjacent to provincial parks do not have formal operating agreements or non-competition clauses with the ministry.

**Ms. Chartier asked the Government the following Question No. 875, which was answered by the Hon. Mr. Hutchinson:**

To the Minister of Tourism, Parks, Culture and Sport: (1) With whom did the consultant who created the Blackstrap Provincial Park report engage in consultations? Answer:

- (1) The consultant engaged a diverse cross section of stakeholder representatives during the public consultations. They included individuals and representatives from organizations such as: urban and rural municipal governments, First Nations, tourism organizations, environmental groups, government agencies, park users, sport and recreation groups such as canoeing, mountain biking, skiing and nature clubs. They also included: recreation-related business persons, park commercial lessees, recreational land developers and area residents. Results of the 2008 survey which used a random telephone survey of residents within 100 km of Blackstrap and drop-in meetings in Saskatoon and Dundurn were also considered by the consultant.

- (2) Fifty-eight individuals, including representatives from thirty-nine groups, were invited to participate in the public consultations. Forty individuals attended representing each of the invited organizations.
- (3) Participants were invited by the consultant via email.
- (4) Invited participants were emailed a variety of background information including preliminary development options for Blackstrap Provincial Park prior to the consultation meeting. The consultant made a formal presentation and explained possible options. The presentation was followed by rotating group breakout discussions involving all attendees. The consultant distributed and emailed a follow-up questionnaire to attendees as well as to those who were unable to attend.
- (5) A consultation meeting was held at the Saskatoon Inn on March 29, 2010. Individual meetings occurred with adjacent landowners following March 29 throughout the summer and fall.
