PROVISIONAL RULE CHANGE

Ordered, That notwithstanding Rules 121 and 141(1), the composition of the Standing Committee on Public Accounts shall consist of eight members including two opposition members for the duration of the Twenty-Seventh Legislature.

MOTION TO AMEND RULE 15 – BUSINESS OF THE ASSEMBLY

On motion of the Hon. Mr. Wyant, by leave of the Assembly:

Ordered, That the *Rules and Procedures of the Legislative Assembly* be amended by adding the following after Rule 15(5):

- 15(6) Any item of business standing in the name of a Minister may be moved by any other Minister in accordance with the conventions which permits Ministers to act for each other on the grounds of the collective nature of the government.
- 15(7) Paragraph (6) of this rule shall apply to the Government House Leader when he or she is not a Minister but is a Member of Executive Council.

MOTION TO AMEND RULE 19 - QUESTION PERIOD

On motion of the Hon. Mr. Wyant, by leave of the Assembly:

Ordered, That the *Rules and Procedures of the Legislative Assembly* be amended by adding the following after Rule 19(4):

19(5) When the Government House Leader is a Member of Executive Council, but not a Minister of the Crown, he or she may be permitted to answer questions in accordance with Rule 19(2).
