(2) Was there a written mandate provided by the Premier? (3) If so what was the content of the mandate? (4) What were the parameters of the task? (5) What were the expenses incurred by the Member for Saskatoon Fairview in completing this task? (6) What was the number of staff assigned to assist the Member for Saskatoon Fairview in this task? (7) What were costs associated with that staff including salary expenses and other related costs?

Answer:

- (1) The Chambers of Commerce of Saskatoon, Regina, and Saskatchewan were asked to put forward names of professional females in the areas of business and entrepreneurship and those with legal backgrounds who may be interested in board governance. The Business and Professional Women's Association in Saskatoon was asked to put a call out for potential board members in those same fields; they forwarded the request to Women Entrepreneurs. Various departments in the Universities of Regina and Saskatchewan were emailed and asked to forward the email to those who might be interested. The member approached women at events she attended and asked interested women to send her their resumé. The member also used her network as an MBA Alumnus of the Edwards School of Business to seek resumé from interested women.
- (2) There was no formal written mandate from the Premier.
- (3) N/A
- (4) Parameters of the task were to increase the number of referrals of professional women (lawyers, academics, business, and entrepreneurs) to the list for potential board appointments.
- (5) None. The work was done while she was performing her duties as the Member for Saskatoon Fairview at various networking events.
- (6) None. Minimal support was provided by the executive director of the Status of Women office and resumé were forwarded to the co-ordinator of agencies, boards, and commissions in Executive Council.
- (7) None.

- (3) Two information sessions for women interested in board governance, sponsored by Crown Investments Corporation and Board Dynamics, were held in Saskatoon on June 12 and June 19, 2012. The Member for Saskatoon Fairview was invited to present and encourage women to put their names forward for potential board appointments. The groups consulted were the Saskatoon

Chamber of Commerce, Regina Chamber of Commerce, Saskatchewan Chamber of Commerce, Business and Professional Women's Association.
