We do not track person-hours devoted to particular files; therefore, it is not possible to quantify costs associated with issuing summary offence tickets.

To the Minister of Labour Relations and Workplace Safety: What are the new processes the Workers' Compensation Board has implemented to reduce the wait times for appeals to be heard by the Workers' Compensation Board?

Answer:

Some of the processes put in place by the Board to reduce wait times for appeals include the following:

- Board governance work has been restructured to concentrate those duties into blocks of time that do not conflict with the Board's appeal responsibilities, leaving more uninterrupted time to conduct hearings and review appeal files.
- Direct reports, who had previously met with the full Board, now meet with the Chair, alone, so that the remaining Board members still have quorum to proceed with appeal hearings, as required.
- The Board has moved to more issue-based executive summaries of appeal files, which reduces the time required to prepare and to review files for appeals.
- Board Services staff continue to review files in their entirety, so that if issues are identified in addition to the issue under appeal, those matters can be referred to the appropriate department for consideration or development, independent of the appeal. However, the original appeal is no longer held in abeyance, pending investigation of such additional issues.
- Hearings are now scheduled through a centralized electronic system instead of the previous manual system.
- The Board increased the number of days per week that it will conduct hearings (3 days instead of 2); and the number of hearings that it will conduct per day (3 or more, as demand dictates, from 2).
- The Board approved booking hearings with a quorum of any two members. The previous Board's practice had been to require that both the representative of workers and the representative of employers be present at every hearing.
- A cancellation list was established so that appellants, who can be available on short notice, can fill unexpected vacancies in the hearing schedule. The Board also reduced the advance notice that it requires for a hearing, from two weeks to one week. This provides more flexibility to move appeals into unexpected openings in the hearing schedule and ensures better utilization of those hearing opportunities.
- The Board authorized the creation of a six-month temporary Appeals Commissioner position. The Appeals Commissioner reviews files and, where he determines that the appeal should be accepted, he has authority to issue a decision to that effect. Where he does not recommend acceptance of the appeal, the file is returned to its original place in the appeal queue, to be prepared for review by the Board. Should the Appeals Commissioner identify any development issues, he refers the matter to the appropriate party to ensure that the file is as appeal ready as possible, when it is ready to be reviewed by the Board.

• Additional staff has been added to type and prepare appeal documents and decisions, to accommodate the increased volume of decisions being produced by the Board.
