#### **PRESENTING PETITIONS**

Petitions of citizens of the province of Saskatchewan were presented and laid upon the Table by the following Members: Chartier and Forbes.

#### **READING AND RECEIVING PETITIONS**

According to Order, the following petitions were favourably examined and pursuant to Rule 16(7) read and received:

Residents of the province of Saskatchewan request that the Legislative Assembly cause the government to make changes so that work related PTSD (Post Traumatic Stress Disorder) is covered under workers compensation and these workers receive the same benefits as others with work-related injuries.

(Addendum to Sessional Paper No. 39)

Residents of the province of Saskatchewan request that the Legislative Assembly cause the government to restore funding for heritage language education in Saskatchewan heritage language schools.

(Addendum to Sessional Paper No. 40)

Residents of the province of Saskatchewan request that the Legislative Assembly cause the government to protect wetlands by increasing funding to do proper inventory work, putting Saskatchewan in a better position to manage the resource, speed up the evaluation of high risk watersheds where there is a significant damage annually from flooding, and create a sound and transparent mitigation process.

Residents of the province of Saskatchewan request that the Legislative Assembly cause the government to restore the RPO rent-to-own option for responsible renters in northern Saskatchewan. (Addendum to Sessional Paper No. 56)

#### SEVENTY-FIVE MINUTE DEBATE

The Order of the Day being called for the following motion for a Seventy-five Minute Debate, it was moved by Mr. Marit:

That this Assembly supports the construction of pipelines including Energy East, Keystone XL, and Northern Gateway, as they are private infrastructure projects that would create jobs, have positive effects on the Saskatchewan economy, be environmentally responsible, safely transport crude oil, and reduce eastern Canada's dependence on foreign oil.

A debate arising, it was moved by Mr. Forbes, in amendment thereto:

That the motion be amended by deleting all the words after the word "construction" and the following be substituted:

of the Energy East, Kinder Morgan Trans Mountain expansion, and Keystone XL pipeline projects, as they will create jobs, have positive effects on the Saskatchewan economy, transport crude oil more safely than possible with trucks and trains, and reduce eastern Canada's dependence on foreign oil; and

That this Assembly recognizes that the Northern Gateway pipeline proposal has been significantly impeded by the federal government's political decision to implement a ban on oil tanker traffic off of the northwest coast of British Columbia; and

That this Assembly supports a collaborative approach to getting pipelines approved that involves working with affected communities and other provincial governments; and further

That this Assembly condemns the ineffective intergovernmental affairs and public relations strategy taken by the Premier that has seen exactly zero kilometres of new pipeline built to tidewater during his time as Premier.

The debate continuing and the period of seventy-five minutes having expired, pursuant to Rule 25(5) the Deputy Speaker interrupted proceedings.

The Order of the Day being called for **Motion No. 2**, it was moved by Mr. Belanger:

That this Assembly call upon the government to fulfill the calls to action in the Truth and Reconciliation Commission's final report that pertain to the jurisdiction of the provincial government.
