PRAYERS

STATEMENT BY THE SPEAKER (UNPARLIAMENTARY LANGUAGE)

Members, I would like to make a ruling on a point of order raised yesterday by the Opposition House Leader (Mr. McCall) concerning a statement made by the Minister of Energy and Resources (Hon. Mr. Duncan) in an exchange with the Member from Nutana, during Question Period on October 26, 2016.

The Opposition House Leader stated that the Minister had contravened Rule 51(f) by using the phrase "false information provided by the Member from Nutana" and suggested the Minister withdraw the comment and apologize. The Government House Leader (Hon. Mr. Merriman) responded that the Minister had not disregarded the rule and requested that I review the Minister's comments.

I have reviewed the Hansard and I am prepared to rule on the matter. The Minister said, and I quote from page 909 of *Hansard*, "I am not sure where to start in my response to all the false information that was provided by the member from Nutana."

Beauchesne's Parliamentary Rules and Forms, 6th Edition, paragraph 494, says: "It is not unparliamentary temperately to criticize statements made by Members as being contrary to the facts; but no imputation of intentional falsehood is permissible. On rare occasions this may result in the House having to accept two contradictory accounts of the same incident." This was supported by Speaker Kowalsky on March 8, 2007, when he stated that the test is whether the words imply direct intent to falsify. I find that the Minister's statement did not imply that the Member was intentionally falsifying information but that the information stated by the Member was in his opinion, false. Therefore, I find the point of order not well taken.
