### MESSAGE OF CONGRATULATIONS

### STATEMENT BY THE SPEAKER Ruling on a Point of Order (Unparliamentary language)

Following question period on May 5, 2023, the Government House Leader (Hon. Mr. Harrison (Meadow Lake)) rose on a point of order alleging that the Member for Regina University (Ms. Young (Regina University)) yelled across the floor, “Don’t trust what Scott’s saying.” I committed to reviewing the record.

On the video, at 10:28 a.m., a member can be clearly heard saying, “I wouldn’t trust what he’s telling you, Scott.” All members know that it is unparliamentary to question the integrity or trustworthiness of other members. I find the point of order well taken, and I would ask the Member from Regina University to withdraw and apologize.

Thereupon, the member from Regina University withdrew her comment and apologized.
