OUESTIONS ORDERED FOR RETURN

The following written questions were converted and orders for return were issued:

Return no. 146 (Ms. Ritchie):

To the Minister Responsible for Water Security Agency, the reason why the water level in Cumberland Lake been permitted to reach dangerously low levels, risking the drinking water supply for the Northern Village of Cumberland House.

Return no. 147 (Ms. Ritchie):

To the Minister Responsible for Water Security Agency, the reason why adequate water outflows are not being maintained from Tobin Lake to safely meet downstream needs in the Northern Village of Cumberland House.

Return no. 148 (Ms. Ritchie):

To the Minister Responsible for Water Security Agency, the emergency plans that are in place to ensure a safe supply of water for the Northern Village of Cumberland House as freeze-up and winter approaches.

Return no. 149 (Ms. Ritchie):

To the Minister Responsible for Water Security Agency, the reason why the Northern Village of Cumberland House has not been contacted directly by Water Security Agency officials and been informed about current and forecasted low water levels in Cumberland Lake that is their only source of drinking water.

Return no. 150 (Ms. Ritchie):

To the Minister Responsible for Water Security Agency, what is being done to restore the lake levels in Cumberland Lake to within a safe level to meet the requirements of the Northern Village of Cumberland House, as well as those of local commercial, traditional and ecosystem needs.

Return no. 151 (Ms. Ritchie):

To the Minister Responsible for Water Security Agency, how the dangerously low water levels in Cumberland Lake conform with the Cumberland House Water Management Agreement and what is being done to restore water levels to meet the water needs of the Northern Village of Cumberland House.
