WRITTEN QUESTIONS

The following questions were given notice on day no. 68 and are to be answered by day no. 73:

1. Question no. 156 (Ms. Ritchie):

To the Minister Responsible for Water Security Agency, why has the water level in Cumberland Lake been permitted to reach dangerously low levels, risking the drinking water supply for the Northern Village of Cumberland House?

2. Question no. 157 (Ms. Ritchie):

To the Minister Responsible for Water Security Agency, why aren't adequate water outflows being maintained from Tobin Lake to safely meet downstream needs in the Northern Village of Cumberland House?

3. Question no. 158 (Ms. Ritchie):

To the Minister Responsible for Water Security Agency, what emergency plans are in place to ensure a safe supply of water for the Northern Village of Cumberland House as freeze-up and winter approaches?

4. Question no. 159 (Ms. Ritchie):

To the Minister Responsible for Water Security Agency, why hasn't the Northern Village of Cumberland House been contacted directly by Water Security Agency officials and been informed about current and forecasted low water levels in Cumberland Lake that is their only source of drinking water?

5. Question no. 160 (Ms. Ritchie):

To the Minister Responsible for Water Security Agency, what is being done to restore the lake levels in Cumberland Lake to within a safe level to meet the requirements of the Northern Village of Cumberland House, as well as those of local commercial, traditional and ecosystem needs?

6. Question no. 161 (Ms. Ritchie):

To the Minister Responsible for Water Security Agency, how do the dangerously low water levels in Cumberland Lake conform with the Cumberland House Water Management Agreement and what is being done to restore water levels to meet the water needs of the Northern Village of Cumberland House?
