That the Legislative Assembly Service provide human resource assistance to the selection panel;

That the selection panel may identify a member of the public with subject matter expertise to provide assistance;

That the selection panel recommend a preferred candidate or candidates, to the board for consideration;

That the name of the candidate approved by the board be transmitted to the Legislative Assembly by the Speaker;

That the recruitment process for the position be concluded so that the Legislative Assembly is able to consider an order for the appointment of the Officer during the fourth session of the twenty-eighth Legislative Assembly.
