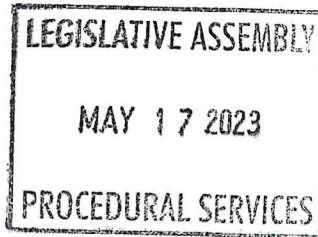

Dear Mr. Bradshaw:

Thank you for the opportunity to appear before your Committee to discuss Bill 92 - *The Automobile Accident Insurance (Miscellaneous) Amendment Act, 2022*.

There was a question from Mr. Teed that we committed to providing information on following the meeting.

**1. How was the amount of \$5,000 determined for the counselling benefit?**

The counselling benefit for an individual injured in an automobile collision was initially established at \$2,500, which was based on an estimate of 10 sessions at a cost of \$250 per session. Stakeholders provided feedback that SGI should expand the counselling benefit so that immediate family members of someone injured in a collision could also access counselling, and further suggested the benefit amount be doubled and the family could determine how best to use it among themselves.
