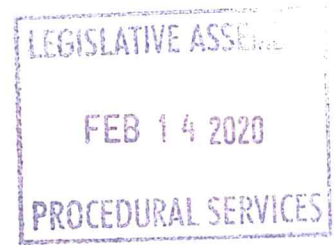

3. What is the breakdown of the number of brokers in each province?


Saskatchewan – 174
