

STANDING COMMITTEE ON ESTIMATES SECOND REPORT

Ms. Hamilton, Chair of the Standing Committee on Estimates presented the Second Report of the said Committee which is as follows:

Your Committee considered the Estimates of the *Legislative Assembly* and adopted the following resolutions:

Main Estimates, 1997-98:

1. Resolved, that there be granted to Her Majesty for the twelve months ending March 31, 1998, the following sum:

For Legislation \$ 5,156,000.

2. Resolved, That towards making good the supply granted to Her Majesty on account of certain expenses of the public service for the fiscal year ending March 31, 1998, the sum of four million, two hundred and ninety-seven thousand dollars be granted out of the General Revenue Fund.

Supplementary Estimates, 1996-97:

1. Resolved, that there be granted to Her Majesty for the twelve months ended March 31, 1997 the following sum:

For Legislation \$113,000.

2. Resolved, that towards making good the supply granted to Her Majesty on account of certain expenses of the public service for the fiscal year ended March 31, 1997, the sum of one hundred thirteen thousand dollars be granted out of the General Revenue Fund.

Your Committee considered the Estimates of the *Ombudsman and Children's Advocate* and adopted the following resolutions:

Main Estimates, 1997-98:

1. Resolved, that there be granted to Her Majesty for the twelve months ending March 31, 1998, the following sum:

For Ombudsman and Children's Advocate \$ 1,496,000.

2. Resolved, That towards making good the supply granted to Her Majesty on account of certain expenses of the public service for the fiscal year ending March 31, 1997, the sum of one million, two hundred and forty-six thousand dollars be granted out of the General Revenue Fund.

Your Committee considered the Estimates of the *Provincial Auditor* and adopted the following resolutions:

Main Estimates, 1997-98:

1. Resolved, That there be granted to Her Majesty for the twelve months ending March 31, 1998, the following sums:

For Provincial Auditor \$ 4,220,000.

2. Resolved, That towards making good the supply granted to Her Majesty on account of certain expenses of the public service for the fiscal year ending March 31, 1998, the sum of three million, five hundred and seventeen thousand dollars be granted out of the General Revenue Fund.

Your Committee recommends that upon concurrence of its report by the Assembly, the sums as reported and approved shall be included in the next Appropriation Bill for consideration by the Legislative Assembly.
