4. The Committee adopted the following resolutions for the Legislative Branch of Government:

**Supplementary Estimates 1999-2000**

- i) Resolved, that towards making good the supply granted to Her Majesty on account of certain charges and expenses of the public service for the fiscal year ending March 31, 2000, the sum of sixty thousand dollars be granted out of the General Revenue Fund. (Mr. Yates)

**Main Estimates: Less Interim Supply No.1**

- ii) Resolved, that towards making good the supply granted to Her Majesty on account of certain charges and expenses of the public service for the fiscal year ending March 31, 2001, the sum of eleven million, thirty-five thousand dollars be granted out of the General Revenue Fund. (Mr. Yates)

5. It was moved by Mr. Prebble:

That this Committee recommend that upon concurrence in the Committee's report, the sums as reported and approved shall be included in the Appropriation Bill for consideration by the Legislative Assembly.

The question being put, the motion was agreed to.

6. The Committee considered a draft report to the Assembly.

It was moved by Mr. Yates:

That the draft report of the Standing Committee on Estimates be adopted and presented to the Assembly.
