Supplementary Estimates — November
Advocate for Children and Youth
Vote 76**

The Deputy Chair: — And with that I would ask that we commence consideration of the supplementary estimates, first of which is the supplementary estimate for the children and youth, subvote (CA01) in the amount of \$261,000. Is that agreed?

Some Hon. Members: — Agreed.

The Deputy Chair: — Seeing no questions for the Speaker, I'd consider it agreed.

I'd ask a member to move the following resolution:

Resolved that there be granted to Her Majesty for the 12 months ended to March 31st, 2014, the following sums for the Advocate for Children and Youth in the amount of \$261,000.
