### **3. Allocation of Business to Policy Field Committees**

Your Committee has adopted a schedule as per Rule 137(3) that allocates government ministries, agencies and Crown corporations to the various committees. Rule 28(7) provides the authority for budgetary estimates to be referred to a committee. There are three types of committees with specific rules for the referral of estimates, policy field committees, Committee of Finance and the Standing Committee on House Services. Rule 141 provides the subject area for policy field committees. Estimates relating to Executive Council are referred to the Committee of Finance as per Rule 117. Pursuant to Rule 137(5), all Estimates for the legislative branch of government are referred to the Standing Committee on House Services. The schedule further provides a guideline for the referral of legislation to standing committees. The schedule is attached as an appendix to this report.

#### **Recommendation**

**That the allocation schedule for committees, as specified in the Appendix to the Second Report of the Standing Committee on House Services, be adopted as per Rule 30(9) and as a guideline in accordance with Rule 137(3) of *The Rules and Procedures of the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan*.**
