Election of Deputy Chair

The committee elected Ms. Nicole Sarauer as the Deputy Chair of the Standing Committee on House Services.

Revisions to the Rules and Procedures of the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan

The committee made a recommendation on revisions to *the Rules and Procedures of the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan*.

Recommendation 1:

That Rule 160 of the *Rules and Procedures of the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan* be amended by omitting Rules 160(4), (5), and (6) and inserting the following:

160(4) Under the direction of the Speaker, the Sergeant-at-Arms shall preserve order and provide security in the legislative precinct.

160(5) In case the Sergeant-at-Arms is absent, the duties shall be performed by any member of the Legislative Protective Service.

160(6) The Sergeant-at-Arms is responsible for the Legislative Protective Service.
