Mr. Kaczkowski: — Good morning, members. As committee Clerk, it is my duty to preside over the election of the Chair, and I will call for nominations for that position now. Mr. Thomson.

Mr. Thomson: — I would nominate Eldon Lautermilch.

Mr. Kaczkowski: — Thank you. Mr. Thomson has nominated Mr. Lautermilch to the position of Chair. Any further nominations? Seeing no further nominations, I would now invite one of the members to move a motion:

That Mr. Lautermilch be elected to preside as Chair of the Standing Committee on Human Services.

Ms. Junor. Ms. Junor has moved:

That Mr. Lautermilch be elected to preside as Chair of the Standing Committee on Human Services.

All in favour of the motion? All those opposed? I declare the motion as carried, and Mr. Lautermilch is elected *in absentia*.

As committee Clerk, it is my duty to preside over the election of an Acting Chair. I will call for nominations for that position now. Mr. Thomson.

Mr. Thomson: — I would nominate Mr. Toth.

Mr. Kaczkowski: — Mr. Thomson has nominated Mr. Toth for the position of Acting Chair. Any further nominations? Seeing no further nominations, I would now invite one of the members to move a motion:

That Mr. Toth be elected to preside as Chair of the Standing Committee on Human Services.

Mr. D'Autremont. Mr. D'Autremont has moved:

That Mr. Toth be elected to preside as Acting Chair of the Standing Committee on Human Services.

All those in favour of the motion? All those opposed? I declare the motion carried and invite Mr. Toth to take the Acting Chair's position.

The Acting Chair (Mr. Toth): — I'll call this meeting to order, and I'm looking for someone to move a motion and the motion will read as such:

That a steering committee be appointed to establish an agenda and priority of business for subsequent committee meetings and that the membership be comprised of the Chair and the Deputy Chair;

And further, that the steering committee shall meet from time to time as directed by the committee or at the call of the Chair; that the presence of all members of the subcommittee is necessary to constitute a meeting; and that substitutions from the membership of the Standing Committee on Human Services be permitted on the steering committee.

Can I have a mover to that motion? Mr. Thomson. A seconder ... [inaudible interjection] ... We don't need a seconder. Mr. Thomson has moved that motion. All in favour?

Mr. Hagel: — Don, sorry, can you just reread the motion? Did it say that all members have to be present for the committee to meet or did I . . .

The Acting Chair (Mr. Toth): — The steering committee.

Mr. Hagel: — Oh, of the steering committee. Yes, okay.

The Acting Chair (Mr. Toth): — It's been agreed to. This committee meeting is adjourned.
