Bill No. 134 — The Opticians Act

The Chair: — Good afternoon, committee members. We are here in consideration of Bill 134, An Act respecting the Profession of Opticians and making a consequential amendment to The Optometry Act, 1985.

We have one substitution this afternoon. For Ms. Junor we have Mr. Yates. All other members are voting members. I welcome the minister to this afternoon's proceedings, and we have an agreement to go section by section on this Bill.

So clause 1 and 2, are those agreed?

Clause 23

The Chair: — Clause 23 as amended, is that agreed? Oh sorry, excuse me. Clause 23, Mr. Hart.

Mr. Hart: — Mr. Chair, I'd like to move the following amendment:

Clause 23

Amend Clause 23 of the printed Bill by striking out clause (1)(a) and substituting the following:

"(a) interpret a prescription and adapt an ophthalmic appliance in accordance with the regulatory bylaws".

I so move, Mr. Chair.

The Chair: — Thank you, Mr. Hart. So clause 23 as amended by Mr. Hart, is that agreed?

Some Hon. Members: — Agreed.

The Chair: — Carried.

[Clause 23 as amended agreed to.]

[Clauses 24 to 57 inclusive agreed to.]

The Chair: — Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows: Bill 134, *The Opticians Act*. Is that agreed?

Some Hon. Members: — Agreed.

The Chair: — Carried. I would ask a member to move that we report Bill 134, *The Opticians Act* with amendment. Mr. Hart. Is that agreed?

Some Hon. Members: — Agreed.
