Please see below information that was requested by committee members on April 10, 2024, regarding the number of beds of all ALC patients that are being placed in community settings.

As of April 10, 2024, the following is the number of beds for ALC patients:

- Kensington – Labine = 15 beds
- Kensington – Mc Arthur = 7 beds
- Diamond House – Warman = 30 beds
- Warm ‘n’ Cozy – Atton = 5 beds
- Warm ‘n’ Cozy – Paton = 9 beds
- Warm ‘n’ Cozy – 110th = 2 beds
- Warm ‘n’ Cozy – 37th = 1 bed
- Beacon House = 5 beds
