2. The committee considered Bill No. 89 – The Education Amendment Act, 2009 (No. 3) / Projet de loi n° 89 – Loi no 3 de 2009 modifiant la Loi de 1995 sur l'éducation.

3. The questions being put on clauses 1 to 10, they were agreed to.

4. During consideration of clause 11, it was moved by Mr. Allchurch:

Clause 11 of the printed Bill

Amend Clause 11 of the printed Bill:

(a) in section 288 of *The Education Act, 1995*, as being enacted by Clause 11 of the printed Bill:

(i) in subsection (1) by adding the following definition in alphabetical order:

“ ‘property tier’ means a

- property tier that is:
- (a) established by the Lieutenant Governor in Council within a property class; and
- (b) based on taxable assessment values; (« *niveau de biens* »);
- (ii) by striking out subsection (3) and substituting the following:
- “(3) The rates to be determined pursuant to subsection (2) may differ:
- (a) for different property classes;
- (b) for different property tiers; and
- (c) for school divisions located wholly or partly within the City of Lloydminster”;
- (iii) by striking out subsection (5) and substituting the following:
- “(5) Subject to subsection (7), the rate for a taxation year determined pursuant to subsection (2) for a property class or property tier is the rate that must be levied in that taxation year on property in the property class or property tier of the taxable assessment of a school division”;
- qui à la fois :

- b) est fonction des valeurs rattachées à l'assiette d'imposition. (“*property tier*”);
- (ii) par suppression du paragraphe (3) et son remplacement par ce qui suit :
- « (3) Les taux à fixer en application du paragraphe (2) pourront varier selon qu'il s'agit :
- a) de différentes catégories de biens;
- b) de différents niveaux de biens;
- c) de divisions scolaires sises complètement ou partiellement dans les limites de la City of Lloydminster »;
- (iii) par suppression du paragraphe (5) et son remplacement par ce qui suit :
- « (5) Sous réserve du paragraphe (7), le taux fixé en application du paragraphe (2) pour une année d'imposition et une certaine catégorie de biens ou un certain niveau de biens est le taux qui doit être appliqué au cours de cette année d'imposition aux biens de la catégorie de biens ou du niveau de biens de l'assiette d'imposition de la division scolaire »;

(iv) by striking out clause (7)(b) and substituting the following:

“(b) not later than April 20 in each taxation year except in the case of the 2009 taxation year, and subject to any directive of the minister, determine the rate in mills to be levied, and, for that purpose, may determine a different rate:

(i) for each property class;
and

(ii) for each property tier”;
and

(b) in subsection 289(1) of *The Education Act, 1995*, as being enacted by Clause 11 of the printed Bill, by adding “except in the case of the 2009 taxation year and” before “except in the case of a newly established school division”.

(iv) par suppression de l’alinéa (7)b) et son remplacement par ce qui suit :

« (b) sous réserve de directives ministérielles, détermine, au plus tard le 20 avril de chaque année d’imposition sauf pour l’année d’imposition 2009, le taux du millième à appliquer et, à cette fin, peut fixer un taux différent :

(i) pour chaque catégorie de biens,

(ii) pour chaque niveau de biens »;

b) au paragraphe 289(1) de la *Loi de 1995 sur l’éducation*, que vise l’article 11 du projet de loi dans sa version imprimée, par insertion de « sauf pour l’année d’imposition 2009 et » avant « sauf dans le cas d’une division scolaire nouvellement constituée ».

The question being put on the amendment, it was agreed to.

The question being put on clause 11 as amended, it was agreed to.

5. The questions being put on clauses 12 to 24, they were agreed to.

6. It was moved by Ms. Eagles:

That the committee report Bill No. 89 – The Education Amendment Act, 2009 (No. 3) / Projet de loi n° 89 – Loi no 3 de 2009 modifiant la Loi de 1995 sur l’éducation – with amendment.
